### What are the FUTURE initiatives?

FUTURE was born from an initiative of the European Digital Learning Network and its members. The initiative "What do you think about the future of digital Education and Training in EU?" was launched between May and September 2017. It was meant to consult at European level different educational organisations and their staff to understand:

FUTURE addresses adult educators in order to provide them with practical tools to improve their skills, as required by the new strategy "Upskilling Pathways: New Opportunities for Adults" (EU 19.12.16 on pathways to improve the level skills: new opportunities for adults).


One of the pillars is to support the initial training and continuous professional development of personnel engaged in the provision of up-skilling paths, particularly teachers and professional trainers. In fact, educators are seen as models in our society and it is vital for them to be equipped with adequate digital skills, to be able to actively participate in the society with the role they play.

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FUTURE INTENDS TO COLLECT AND ANALYZE LEARNING METHODOLOGIES AND PRACTICES THROUGH DIGITAL TOOLS, WITH THE OBJECTIVE TO REALIZE SIMPLE GUIDELINES FOR ADULT EDUCATORS.

The FUTURE results will be:

A collection of case studies related to the most effective methods applied to learning through ICT.



A database of free tools available online, customizable, open source and easily adaptable to multiple subjects, that will be analysed and decoded by project partners according to their propensity to adapt to the needs of both the educator and learner.



A resource kit that will collect the results of the previous points.
